One goal of the computer lab is to provide you with a stable and consistent computing environment. To be able to accomplish this, there were several measures completed as of last Friday, September 19th.

1. All computers were reformatted and re-installed updated applications.
2. Recommend using Internet Explorer (IE) as a primary web browser because of installed multimedia plug-in (Adobe Flash, Shockwave, Java, & others). Use Firefox when IE does not work.
3. Mandatory profile is active. This means every computer that you use will have the same desktop and configuration setup. (First time implementation)
4. Default printer is FinePrint. With FinePrint you can print 2, 4, or 8 pages on a single sheet of paper which saves money.

Attached to this e-mail is directions on how to print using FinePrint.

These computers are about 3.5 years old and I am making my best effort to keep them running as fast as possible. Please feel free to reply to this e-mail with questions, comments or suggestions.
